Creating and delivering presentations is a vital life skill in all walks of life, especially for those involved in Christian ministry. By the end of this course, the student will know how to prepare and deliver engaging and professional presentations.

Learning Objectives

- Define the objectives for a presentation by using the ATT and IMPI methods.
- Structure a presentation with an effective introduction, body, and conclusion.
- Use visual aids effectively in presentations.
- Present data effectively by translating them into a story.
- Rehearse your presentation by using the STATE method.
- Assess a presentation by evaluating the five key elements.
- Use practical strategies to reduce and manage presentation nerves.
- Handle challenging questions wisely after a presentation.
